

North Lewisburg Village Council Regular Meeting

February 10, 2026

The Village of North Lewisburg Council met on February 10, 2026, at 6:30PM in the Village Community Room.

Mayor Murphy called the meeting to order. Roll call was answered by Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Nobbs, Mr. Burden and Mr. Warner, Mrs. Wirtz and Mrs. Warner. All present Joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Warner moved to accept the January 13, 2026 Regular Meeting Minutes, Mr. Huffman Seconded, all in favor.

FISCAL OFFICER:

MAYOR:

Mayor Murphy reminded the group to watch out for children as the weather begins to improve and to watch out for ice as the temperatures drop overnight.

ADMINISTRATOR:

Administrator Freyhof provided an update on the IRS Penalties and Interest. Administrator Freyhof has reached out to Mr. Bagshaw from Senator Moreno's off on 2-5-26 for an update. Mr. Bagshaw replied stating he has reached back out to his contact for an update.

Administrator Freyhof updated the group on the Cyber Security requirements and quotes. Mr. Freyhof met with a local Chief Information Officer on February 4th. He provided a risk analysis of our computer network and we tested pretty secure. He pointed out a couple of vulnerabilities and advised hoe to repair. Mr. Freyhof reached out to Berry Digital we have improved those vulnerabilities. The information officer advised that we probably don't require a full cyber contractor, but does recommend 24-hour surveillance with the ability to quarantine and repair a device. Mr. Freyhof is currently researching this option. Our current Tech contractor EGreen is recommending a \$4000.00 server upgrade at the Mayor's Office and a \$1500.00 Mirachi Firewall for the Police. I have attached a cyber security resolution for next month. I have sent it to Egreen Tech Support and Solicitor Anthony Will for Review.

Administrator Freyhof asked council if they would like to move forward with the new server and firewall. Mrs. Wirtz moved to approve purchasing the \$4000.00 Server and \$1500.00 Firewall, Mrs. Warner, seconded. Roll Call Mr. Burden, yes; Mrs. Huffman, yes; Mr. Nobbs, yes; Mrs. Warner, yes; Mr. Warner, yes; and Mrs. Wirtz, yes.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

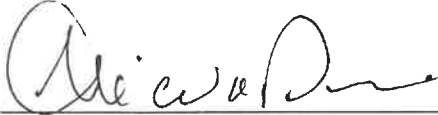
