

RESOLUTION NO. 10-16-2025(A)

ADOPTED: 10-16-2025

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A H2OHIO GRANT THROUGH THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH LEWISBURG FOR CONSTRUCTION OF WATER FACILITIES; AND DESIGNATING A DEDICATED REPAYMENT SOURCE FOR THE LOAN AND DECLAIRING AN EMERGENCY:

Whereas, the Village of North Lewisburg seek to upgrade its existing wastewater facilities; and

Whereas, the Village of North Lewisburg intends to apply for an H2Ohio construction grant for the water facilities; and

Whereas, the Ohio EPA requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of the H2Ohio grant and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source; now therefore,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of North Lewisburg, Ohio:



SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to apply for a H2Ohio or grant, sign all documents for and enter into a H2Ohio grant agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority for construction of water facilities on behalf of the Village of North Lewisburg, Ohio and any overage costs will be paid through the water funds.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said Village of North Lewisburg for the reason that the immediate construction of the Water Treatment Plant Improvements 2023 for decommission of the aerator and filter repairs at the earliest possible time is necessary in order to protect the health of the inhabitants of the LGA by providing safe and affordable drinking water to residents; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
