The Village of North Lewisburg Council met on January 30, 2025 at 6:30PM am in the Village Community Room for a Special Meeting for the purpose of introducing Resolution 1-30-2025 Resolution of Intent for reimbursement of proceed for the WWTP Access Road and 2 proposed considerations of employment, dismissal, discipline, promotion, demotion or compensation of a public employee or official


Mayor Murphy read Resolution of Intent 1-30-2025. Mrs. Street moved to approve, Mrs. Warner seconded, all in favor.




